New Enhancement for 2014-2015: Survey Results by Individual Schools within the Institution

Main Switchboard: IPEDS/CDS Front-End

The IPEDS/CDS front-end allows authorized users to access the back-end data and filter for subsets of students, based on any number of student attributes, such as school, department, major, first-time, full-time, first generation, residency, race, gender, age, etc. All calculations are performed within Microsoft's enterprise SQL Server. Calculations can be verified; clicking on any number instantly displays the students underlying the calculation. The "Source" data for all survey parts can easily be viewed.

New enhancement for 2014-2015 is automation of survey results by individual schools within the institution.

The 2015 SFA survey provides award data for all Fall 2013 undergraduates (Part B) as well as more detailed award data for first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen (Parts C - G).

Data includes the number of students receiving awards, total awards, and average awards broken down by 1) federal grants; 2) state/local grants; 3) institutional grants; and 4) loans to students.

The *Main Form*, shown here, displays Parts A, B, and C. The user can print Parts A-C only or the entire survey (red arrows). *All Schools* have been selected (red oval). Clicking on any calculations displays the underlying students and awards (slides 5-6).

The *Source* buttons (blue oval) will be covered on slides 7-9. Sections D/E and F/G can be viewed as separate forms (blue arrows), as shown on slides 10-14 and 15-16.


Beginning with 2014-2015, IPEDS and CDS surveys can be viewed/printed for each school.

Here, the user has filtered for the Fall 2013 GRS-Cohort (arrow).

Students will appear multiple times if they have more than one financial aid award, e.g., Kellen Winter who received a Federal Pell grant and a state grant (rectangle).
