S REGIS 8.0: IPEDS/CDS Reporting

The IPEDS/CDS front-end allows authorized users to access the back-end data and filter for subsets of students, based on any number of student attributes, such as school, department, major, first-time, full-time, first generation, residency, race, gender, age, etc. All calculations are performed within Microsoft's enterprise SQL Server. Calculations can be verified; clicking on any number instantly displays the students underlying the calculation. The "Source" data for all survey parts can easily be viewed.

New enhancement for 2014-2015 is automation of survey results by individual schools within the college/university.
