The IPEDS methodolgy provides an estimate of full-time equivalent student (FTES) based on overall institutional enrollment. When determing the student-faculty ratio (SFR) by school, this method is flawed in that students from one school generally take courses outside of their enrollement school. A high SFR for one school may indicate higher overall course enrollment and/or a greater ratio of student course enrollment IN OTHER SCHOOLS, or vice versa.

A more accurate method for schools is to base FTES on total course credits taught within the school. The Average Credit Load (ACL) for a full-time student (line IS-2) is calculated based on total credit hours FOR THER INSTITUTION divided by number of full-time equivalent students (line 4) FOR THE INSTITUTION. Total credit hours within all schools or the selected school, as applicable, are divided by ACL to calculate the FTES. When 'All Schools' is selected, SFR based on Student Enrollment (line 18) and Student Credit Hours (IS-4) will be identical.
